#### 1. Read together

- 1 Samuel 17: 26-52

#### 2. Questions:

- Initial thoughts/questions?

- What types of doubts or discouragement are you most susceptible to? How do you overcome them?

- David's faith led him to decisive action. In your life, what decisive action(s) does your faith lead to?
- What difference does God's past work, current presence, and promises make in your life?
