Becoming a Person of Worship & Thanksgiving

1. Read together

- Psalm 111

2. Questions:

- Initial thoughts/questions?
- How did the Psalmist express worship and thanksgiving? How do we typically worship and offer thanksgiving today?
- How did the early church worship? (see Acts 2:42,46; 1 Cor. 11:27) Do you think there should be some consistency with early church worship and how we worship today? How so?
- How does remembering what God has done (and promises to do) lead to worship?
- What role does reflecting on God and the teaching from his Word play in worship?
- How should we respond in worship and thanksgiving? What kind of responses to true worship and thanksgiving lead to in your life?

3. Break into smaller groups of men and women to share and pray
